

## FY2024 City-sponsored Japanese Language Classes for Non-Native Speakers (2nd Term)

The City of Wakayama will be offering Japanese language classes to non-native speakers, who live or work in Wakayama City.



**【Description】** There are 15 classes per course.

<b>Course 1</b>	This course begins with hiragana and katakana.
<b>Course 2</b>	This course is for people who can read and write hiragana and katakana. It is the continuation of course 1 (FY2024), however, previous completion is not required.

<b>Location</b>	Wakayama City Hall, 7 <sup>th</sup> floor briefing room (きしゃかいけんしつ 記者会見室)
<b>Fee</b>	Free (but <b>must purchase</b> your own textbook)
<b>Textbook</b>	“Nihongo 45 Jikan”; “Nihongo 45 Jikan Renshucho” ※ You can purchase the texts online or at bookstores.
<b>Teacher</b>	Professor Hirano Noriko
<b>Schedule</b>	From <b>October 2024</b>
<b>Time</b>	Course 1: Thursdays, 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM Course 2: Tuesdays, 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM ※ No class if Tuesday or Thursday is a holiday.
<b>Capacity</b>	20 people per course ※If the class has not reached full capacity, you can join anytime throughout the term.
