02 Preventing Food Poisoning - Follow the Three Golden Rules  
Keep Germs Out, Prevent Growth, Kill with Heat

As temperatures rise, bacteria like campylobacter & salmonella multiply more easily, increasing the risk of food poisoning. Protect yourself and your family by keeping these three principles in mind:

## Keep Germs Out

Wash your hands thoroughly before cooking, as they can carry many kinds of germs. Be careful to avoid cross-contamination—sanitize cutting boards and utensils after handling raw meat or fish to prevent contaminating foods eaten raw, like salads or fruit.

## Kill with Heat

Most harmful bacteria and viruses can be destroyed with heat. As a rule of thumb, cook meat to a core temperature of 75°C for at least one minute. Kitchen tools like cutting boards, knives, and cloths used for raw meat, fish, or eggs should be washed with detergent and then disinfected—either with boiling water, bleach, or alcohol spray.

## Prevent Growth

Foodborne bacteria thrive at temperatures between 20°C and 50°C. Refrigerate perishable items such as sashimi and other raw ingredients as quickly as possible to stop bacteria from multiplying.

### Child-Care Support Subsidy

A subsidy is available for families raising three or more children of primary school age or younger. This helps cover the cost of childcare services for younger children. ▼ **Maximum Subsidy:** ¥15,000 per year ▼ **Eligible Services:** Temporary day-care (limited to nursery facilities), Family Support Center services, care for sick or recovering children, short-stay and twilight-stay child support services.

▼ **Application Deadline:** End of March 2026

※ Claims for services used in March 2026 may be submitted until the end of April

### Marriage

### “New Life” Marriage Support Program

This program assists newly married couples with expenses related to starting their life together, such as housing and moving costs.

▼ **Maximum grant:** Up to ¥600,000 (amount varies depending on the couple's age at the time of marriage)

▼ **Eligibility:** Couples who marry between January 1, 2025, and March 31, 2026, and meet the program's age and income criteria

▼ **Eligibility:** ① Registered city residents aged 65 ② Registered city residents aged 60–64 with qualifying severe heart, kidney, respiratory or immune disorders (equivalent to Disability Grade 1) ※ First timers only. ▼ **Personal expense:** ¥ 3,000 (Free for welfare recipients) ▼ **Cut-off:** The day before your 66th birthday
