Expansion of Child Allowance System

The child allowance system will partially Inquiries: Cl change following the Oct 2024 installment. \$\mathbb{G}\$435-1219

Expanded Applicability

The allowance will now apply to children up to the end of the fiscal year in which they turn 18.

No more income limits

Income limits and special allowances will be removed, making everyone applicable.

Payment Increase

From 0-2 years old (1st & 2nd child) ¥ 15,000/month

From 3 - high school (1st & 2nd child) ¥ 10,000/month

From 0 - high school (3rd child & above) ¥30,000/month

※Children of university age (up to the FY in which they turn 22) can count as the 1st child in calculations, making you applicable for the multi-child allowance.

New Payment Schedule

Payments will now be made 6 times (formerly 3) a year. The amount for each period will be distributed on the 10th day of even numbered months. Starting from Oct 2024 (the installment for Jun to Sep), notifications of payment will no longer be sent by mail.

Please apply if:

You have not been receiving the child allowance due to income limitations.

You are not receiving the child allowance, but have dependent children under 18 (the FY in which they turn 18).

You are currently receiving the allowance, but have a total of 3 or more children, with some being of university age (the fiscal years in which they turn 18-22).
