Expansion of the Child-Rearing Allowance

Starting Nov 2024, updates to child-rearing allowances for single-parent households and similar families will take effect. First updated payment: Jan 10, 2025 (for Nov-Dec).

Higher Allowances for 3rd+ Children

The allowance for the 3rd+ child will now match the 2nd child. Higher limits for full/partial eligibility:

	Full Payment	Partial Payment
1st Child	¥45,500	¥45,490~¥10,740
2 nd	¥10,750	¥10,740~¥5,380
<u>3rd+</u>	Same as 2 nd child	

New Calculation Formula for Partial Payments

First Child: ¥45,490 - [Income - Income Limit] × 0.025

Second Child+: \(\frac{1}{2}\)10,740 - [Income - Income Limit] \(\times 0.0038561\)
