01 Notice Regarding the Support Allowance for Rising Prices

To assist residence tax-exempt households affected by rising prices, the city will provide 30,000 yen per eligible household. If the household includes children aged 18 or under, an additional 20,000 yen will be provided per child. For details, please see the city website (ID: 1060851 / ID: 1060888).

(1) Allowance for Households Exempt from Residence Tax

- Amount: 30,000 yen per household
- Eligibility: Households listed in Wakayama City's Basic Resident Register as of the reference date, where all members are exempt from resident tax for FY2024.

Note: Households consisting only of tax dependents of a taxable individual, or those exempt under a tax treaty, are excluded.

In the following cases, you may be eligible by submitting an application:

- ① Your household includes someone who moved to Wakayama City on or after January 2, 2024.
- ② Your household includes someone who has not yet filed a resident tax declaration.

(2) Additional Child Allowance

- Amount: 20,000 yen per child
- Eligibility: Among the households eligible under (1), those with children aged 18 or younger (until March 31 following their 18th birthday).

You may also be eligible in these situations with an application:

- ① You have a child born on or after December 14, 2024.
- ② You support a child who lives separately from your household.

How to apply: ① **If you received a confirmation form** → Review the contents, fill out the necessary information, and return the form. ② **If you believe you are eligible but haven't received any documents** → Contact the administrative office to request the application form and submit it along with the required documents.

▼ **Payment Date:** Once the submitted documents have been reviewed, payments will be issued on a rolling basis. ▼ **Application Deadline:** Jul 31 (Thu), 2025 ▼ **Reference Date:** Dec 13 (Fri), 2024

Get Paid to Go Green! Energy-Efficient Appliance Subsidy

Save money while saving the planet! The city is offering a subsidy for households that upgrade to energy-efficient air conditioners or refrigerators.

- **Subsidy Details:** Covers 50% of eligible costs (up to ¥50,000)※One appliance per household (choose either AC or fridge) ※First-come, first-served—apply early before funds run out!
- **Who's Eligible:** Heads of households registered in Wakayama City who purchase and install a new, energy-saving model.
- **Eligible Products:**
 - ① Home AC: 3-star+ Uniform Energy-Saving Label (FY2027 std.)
 - ② Home Fridge: 3-star+ Uniform Energy-Saving Label (FY2021 std.)

※Must be purchased from a store within Wakayama City. ※Must be bought and installed on or after April 14.

How to Apply: After installation, submit the required documents in person, by email, or via LoGo Form. Applications accepted starting April 14 (Mon).

Subsidies for Removing Hazardous Block Walls

Old or unstable block walls can collapse during a quake and block emergency routes or school paths. Wakayama City offers support to remove or replace these walls with safer, lightweight fencing.

Eligible Walls: Must face school routes or roads regulated by the Building Standards Act

	Subsidy Details	Max Amount
⑧ Wall Removal	70% or two-thirds of either the removal cost or (¥15,000 × wall length in meters), whichever is lower.	⑧&⑨: ¥400,000
⑨ New Lightweight Fence	Two-thirds of either the installation cost or (¥15,000 × wall length in meters), whichever is lower.

Beginning April 1, the documentation required to receive free cancer screenings will change. Be sure to follow the correct procedures based on your eligibility.

Eligible Individuals		How to Apply for the Fee Waivers
Households Exempt from Municipal Residence Tax	All household members are exempt.	Apply in advance to the Regional Health Div. for a Cancer Screening Free Voucher and present it at your appointment. (Apply via internet or mail at least 2 weeks before your screening.)
	Persons classified under Category I or II whose income level corresponds to that of a non-taxable household under the Elderly Medical Care System.	No application needed. Just bring your My number Insurance Card or certificate of eligibility to your screening.
Public Assistance Receipts		Get a screening ticket from your caseworker before your appointment and present it on the day.
Recipients of Medical Assistance for Severe Disabilities		Bring your Medical Assistance Beneficiary Certificate to your screening.

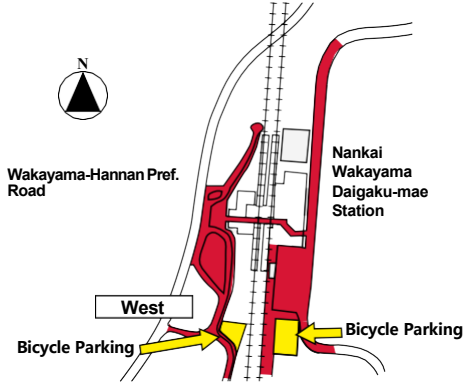
Unattended Bicycles & Motorized Bicycles Cause Major Disruptions

※The red ■ areas are designated no-parking zones.

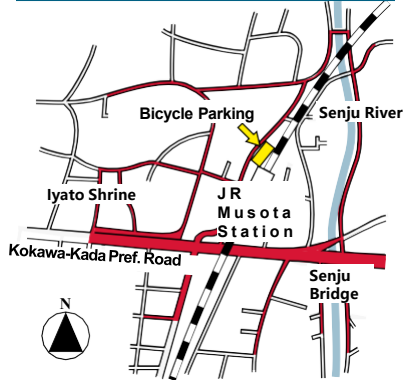
Around Nankai Wakayamadaigakumae Station



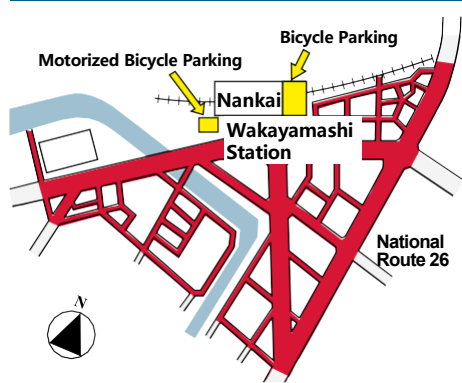
Why It Matters

 - Increases the risk of theft and worsens the city's appearance

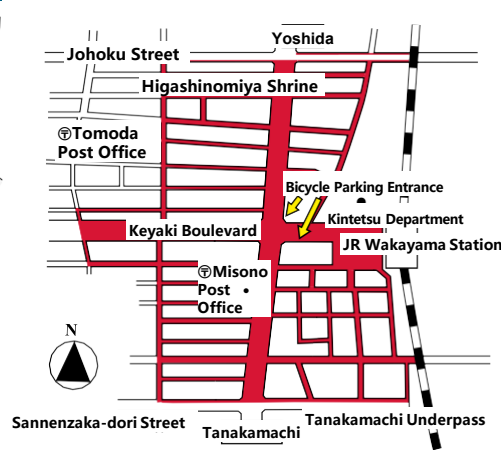
Around JR Musota Station



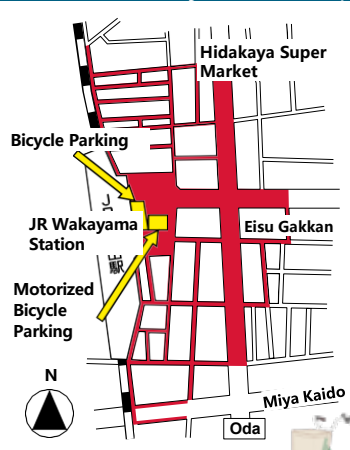
Around Nankai Wakayamashi Station

☞ Payment slips will be mailed by the Japan Pension Service in early April.

Student Payment Deferral – Now Open for Applications

If your 2024 income is below a set threshold, you may qualify to defer pension payments while in school.

Who's Eligible:

Students enrolled in programs of 1 year or more at:

- Universities / Grad schools
- Junior colleges / High schools
- Specialized vocational highschool
- Schools for the visually/hearing impaired
- Special-needs schools (high school dept.)
- Specialized training colleges
- Part-time / correspondence courses at universities, colleges, or high schools

What You'll Need to Apply:

- Basic Pension Number Notification (Pension Booklet)
- Student ID or Enrollment Certificate
- If unemployed: Proof of unemployment (e.g., dismissal notice)
